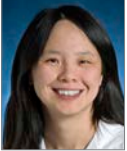

Outcomes for burn patients have improved dramatically over the past 20 years, yet burns still cause substantial morbidity and mortality. Proper evaluation and management, coupled with appropriate early referral to a specialist, greatly help in minimizing suffering and optimizing results.

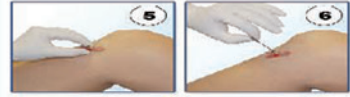
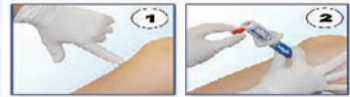
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Instructions for Use

- Place pad on wound & wrap the elastic bandage to a normal fit on body part.
- Insert a roll of bandage into pressure applicator.
- Tighten a roll to wrap area.
- Push back over 2 pressure applicator lower roller past.
- Press roller over top part of your pressure applicator. Do not over-tighten or pin.
- Final check of bandage. Do not use if it is not a bandage.
